Thank you for your interest in applying for our Emerging Principles in Child & Youth Ministry (PCYM) School here in Thailand! ### **Some General Information:**

The Principles in Child & Youth Ministry (PCYM) School is an accredited University of the Nations school which is designed to provide you with excellent teaching and tools for you to do children and youth ministries. Some of the content covered includes: foundational teaching on the character of God as it relates to working with young people, human development, understanding the physical, emotional and mental development from pre-birth to teens, examining problems of dysfunctional families and families at risk, foundational principles and values of Kings Kids, principles of releasing young people in worship, intercession, evangelism, and leadership.

A unique side to our particular PCYM here in Thailand is the focus on incorporating the outdoors and experiential learning in the teaching and outreach context. Students may develop their skills in facilitating outdoor NIKO camps for young people, and providing leadership for child and family camps.

The lecture phase will take place in Bangkok at YWAM Ram2 NRTC Training center with student and staff housing in the Training center area and near by. ### **Completing Your Application:**

The following items must be submitted in full before we can process your application. Return all forms to the Registrar, at the address above. All of the questions on the application must be completed. If a question does not apply to you, please write "N/A" (not applicable) in the space provided. Husbands and wives must complete separate application forms.

## **Application Checklist:**

- Personal Information Form.** Please fill out completely, attach a recent photo of yourself, and sign the application form.
- PCYM Application Form.** Please fill out completely, and sign the application form.
- Registration Fee.** Your 250 Bath (500 bath per married couple) must be sent with the application. This fee is not refundable, and your application cannot be processed without it.
- Acknowledgement of Financial Responsibility.** This section on the PCYM Application Form must be signed. If you are under 18 years of age, please be sure to have a parent/guardian sign the form as well.
- Medical Forms.** You must fill out and submit with your application the Confidential Health History Form and the Release Form. You must also have your doctor fill out and sign the Physician's Evaluation Form, which must also be sent directly to the Registrar. Separate forms must be filled out for all school age children.
- Confidential References.** Three confidential reference forms are enclosed. One reference form should be given to each of the following: 1) DTS/YWAM Leader 2) Pastor/YWAM Leader 3) Friend. Please fill out and sign the top portion of the form with your information before distributing the form. Please request that the reference person fills out the form completely, and mails it directly to the Registrar at KKI Thailand. You may want to give them a pre-addressed, stamped envelope with our KKI Thailand address on it. Note: references from family members will not be accepted. Your application cannot be processed until these reference forms are received.

IMPORTANT: Applications for Thai citizens must be received no later than two weeks prior to the start of the school, and for non-Thai citizens, four weeks prior to the start of the school. It is very important that at least the Personal Information Form portion of the application be sent in with the registration fee as soon as possible as this will enable us to keep a count of those interested in attending.

FOR NON-Thai APPLICANTS: Upon acceptance to the school, we will send you the necessary documents for you to apply for your visa. Please do not attempt to apply for these documents until you receive official acceptance from the school with that necessary information.

Please ensure that your application is returned directly to YWAM/KKI in Thailand as quickly as possible so your application may be processed.
